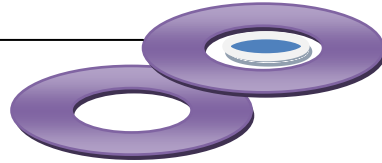

The second year under graduate students of the Hits college students hosted a welcome party to the freshers .The celebrations were arranged for the students at the auditorium of the hits campus.

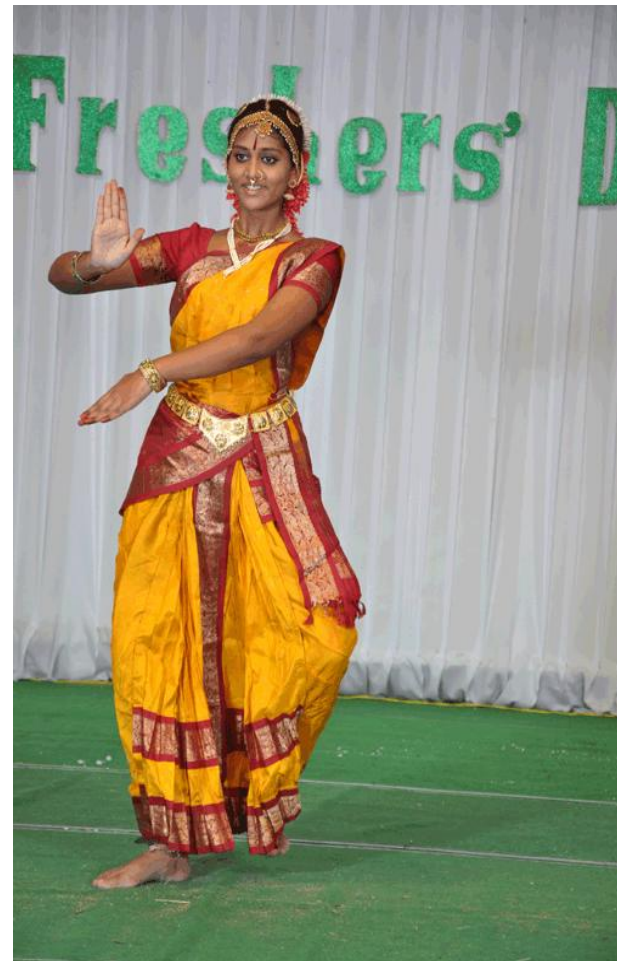
The newcomers were made to interact with the seniors through various interactive activities while the highlight of the day was the Mr. and Miss. Freshers' contest
